FOR LITTLE SILVER LOCAL AMANDA DIETZ, 2020 ended on a high note. Dietz had grown up here in Little Silver, attending school locally throughout her childhood, and her parents still live in town to this day. She also has recently become engaged to Little Silver Neighbors' very own publisher, Ryan Keating. animals is our passion, we also provide rehabilitation, outreach, assistance and education where needed. This past year has shown us that even in the toughest of times, when good people come together, we can make miracles happen." —That was when Greenway came in.

In only three short days, from December 28th to December 31st, Dietz helped raise \$7,260 through a Facebook and direct donation drive. In addition, with the community and Greenway employees coming together to help this amazing cause, Payor decided to triple match what was raised, for a donation of \$21,780. A total of \$29,040 in donations was generously made to this wonderful organization. "This extremely generous and unexpected gesture from James and Greenway was exactly what we needed to close out a very challenging year," Frannie says gratefully.

Greenway prides itself in giving back to others, supporting local charities such as the Monmouth County SPCA and Lunch Break, just to name a couple of the established charitable organizations they have helped support over the years. "Greenway's philanthropic efforts have mostly centered around causes where the beneficiaries do not have a voice and cannot advocate for themselves," Payor emphasizes. "The environment, homelessness and certainly animals have been our main focus."



Important Trash and Recycling Information for All Residents

Bulk collection is always your second pickup of the week and includes furniture and carpeting. No more than three items can be placed at the curb per pickup and must be placed to the curb the night before, along with any regular trash. No appliances, electronics or construction material permitted. No more than three items per week.

Pickup is every week as follows:

Zone 1: Monday and Thursday
Zone 2: Tuesday and Friday

Single-Stream Recycling

Bottles, cans, plastic, newspaper, small cardboard and mixed paper can all be placed in the same container. Cardboard that is too large for a container should be flattened, tied and placed next to the container.

Pickup is every other week as follows:

Zone 1: Wednesday February 10th, Wednesday February 24th

Zone 2: Wednesday February 3rd, Wednesday February 17th Note: As of October 2019, single use plastic bag, polystyrene container and plastic straw use are prohibited in Little Silver. The Borough is giving away reusable bags at Borough Hall and in the Library. 


